Concerned about a student being vulnerable and at risk of Radicalisation / Grooming?

Non Urgent Concern

Urgent Concern

Record CPOMS
*Factual information only, in bullet point format.
Apply CIA*

Talk to: Pastoral team
Year Team
Inclusion Team
Keyworker

Consider which of the pastoral team knows and supports the student the most.

Log information on CPOMS using CIA

Pastoral staff to add information to CPOMS and ensure appropriate referrals and educational work is completed.

Report to a DSL if the concern is repeat or deemed urgent.

Potential Outcomes

Concern raised – Educational discussion – No further action

Concern raised – repeat offence
Educational work, sanction and parental discussion.
Consider PREVENT advice line

Concern raised – repeat of similar concern(s)
PREVENT advice line – external work (if possible) or extended internal work, parental meeting and sanction if appropriate.

Repeat / Urgent concern: Channel referral completed

Inclusion Referral form completed

Student discussed at Inclusion Panel

Written record / action plan created.

Further concern over safety and grooming / exploitation?

Please note: If a student makes racial comments, they should be reported to DSL/DDS and it must be recorded on CPOMS using CIA. Known repeat offences must be reported to DSL and also recorded on CPOMS, linking in students who are involved or affected.
