### **RAISING ADDITIONAL ESSENTIAL FUNDS FOR OUR SCHOOL – SUMMER TERM SPONSORED EVENTS**

Last week, I wrote to advise you of our fund raising intention so that we can maintain, replace and improve resources for our children. Thank you for your positive feedback. We would like to raise money this time to complement and add to our guided reading books and home readers to give our children in every class more choice of books including classics and books from the top 100 list for their age. These will enable us to enthuse and engage further our children's love of reading which in turn develops language and communication. After speaking to some of the children, we have decided that we would like to host our first sponsorship event as part of our Health and Fitness Week, next week. So I am writing to ask you to support our event by helping your child/ren gather sponsorship from family and friends **for an amazing Summer Obstacle Course**.

Using their ideas, the content of the obstacle course will include 10 key activities, some of which are:

- Running in their pyjamas
- Balancing over items with a bean bag on their head
- Cargo net scramble
- Water cannon (well not quite a cannon!) and more

**Children will NEED their trainers in school ALL week**

**Children will need to bring in a bag with their pyjamas and a towel on Tuesday (may need to leave in school for remainder of week due to time or weather)**

This will be a great fun, fitness activity – sure to raise smiles, laughter and memories whilst raising money to enhance their learning experiences in school. The course length will change according to the age of the child; however, all 10 obstacles will be included for all classes.

We would like to ask each child to try **and raise a minimum of £20** (only a sponsorship of £2.00 per obstacle) to achieve our target amount although if you can help raise more, this would be fantastic and really help our goal. If we are really lucky to raise more than our target, we will put this to our next goal of replacing classroom tables and chairs in our classrooms.

Of course this is a voluntary sponsored event, and all children will be able to take part but your support will make a big difference to how quickly I am able to replace and upgrade our resources, which will benefit every child at Bretherton.
