We continually want to improve and work hard to ensure that we are developing our curriculum, opportunities and all round education.

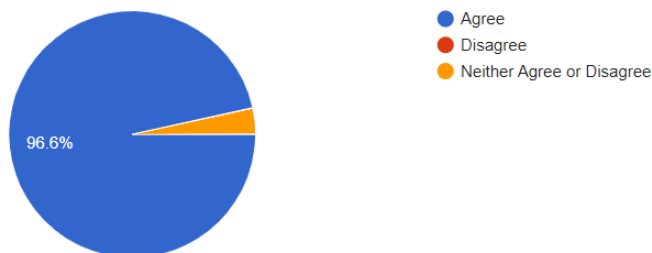

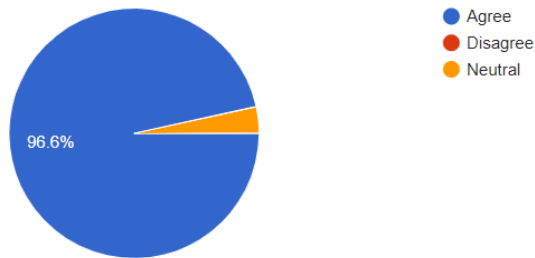

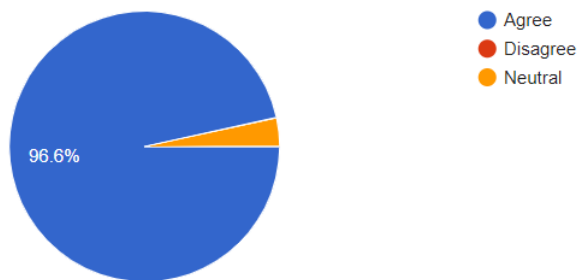

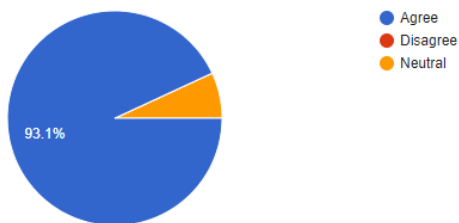

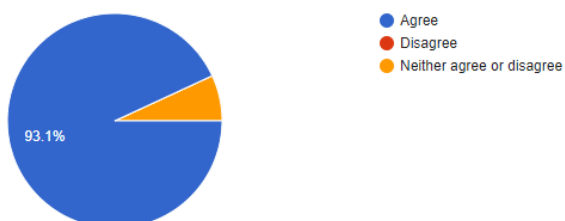

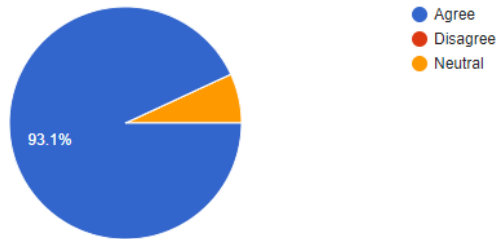

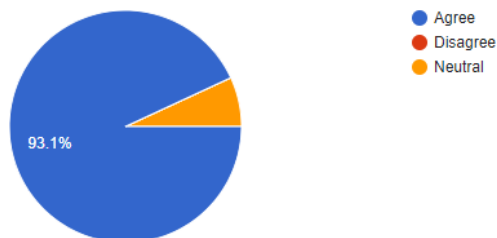

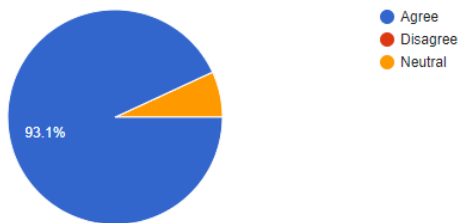

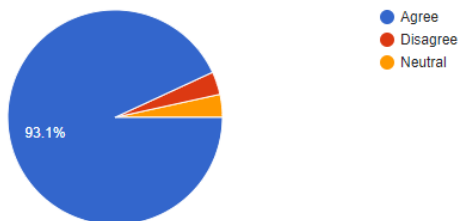

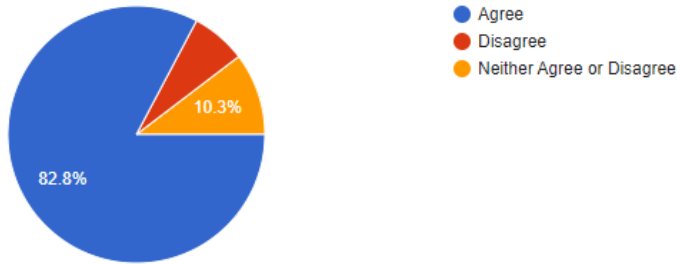

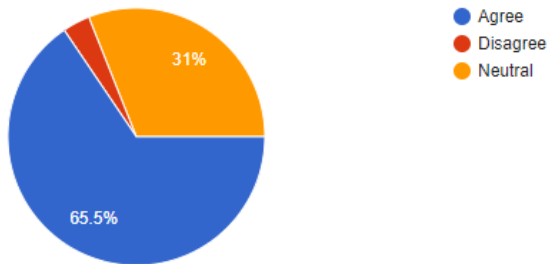

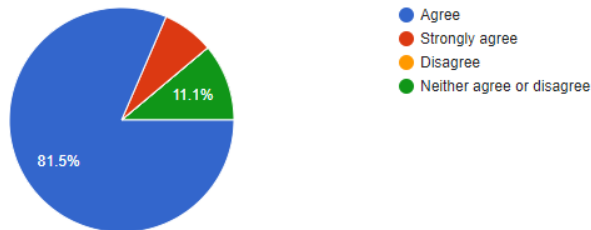

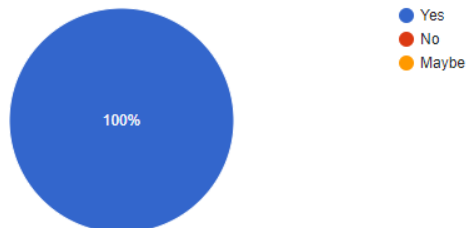

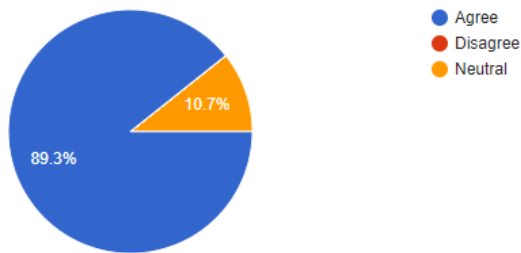

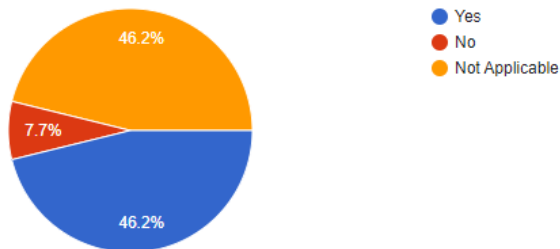

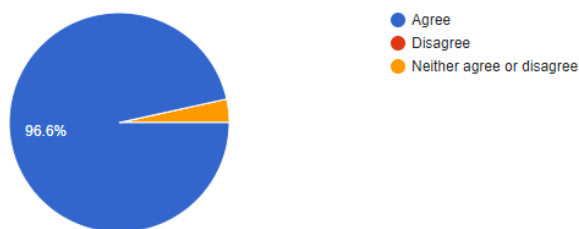

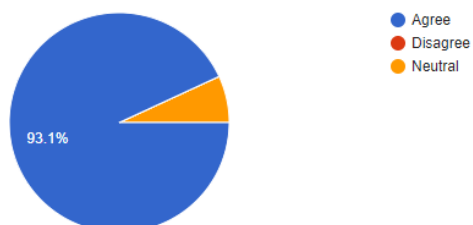

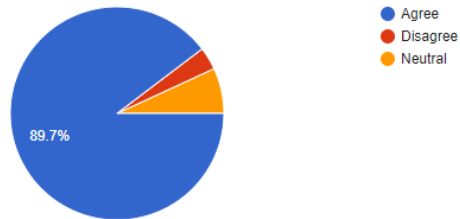

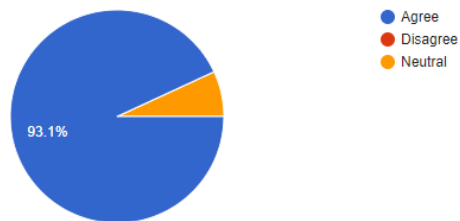

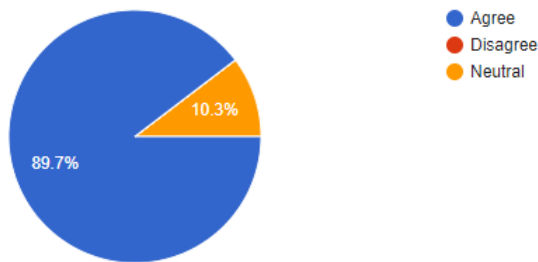

Actions as a result of the questionnaire Oct 2022

Focus	Action	Completed
1. Communication streamlined	Look at streamlining the communication. After relaunching the newsletter as a sway and having all details on the school website eg calendar upto date. 1 app possible that can offer messages. Parent feedback to be gathered at parent forum.	
2. Children's progress	To remind parents of when they will be updated about their child's progress. To ask at Parent forum to review if any changes could be made.	
3. After school sports	To reflect on the number of clubs available run by staff acknowledging that staff run the clubs in their own time and the fee goes towards paying for the resources. In addition, there is a limited availability for classrooms and the hall for such clubs	
4. Affordable after school wrap around care	To review charging of wrap around care before April budget setting. There have been no increases in cost since 2018 when we took over and created the hub. Challenge for our school is limited

5. Education on money/ life skills.	Outline to parents where this is in our PHSE Jigsaw coverage and Debt aware as we have more than included in NC coverage in our curriculum. To use parent forum as avenue to check what additional information or coverage parents would be looking for.
